Aircel, BSNL sign pan-India intra-circle roaming pact

State-run telecom player Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited (BSNL) has entered into an intra-circle roaming agreement with private operator Aircel for all circles. This deal is expected to improve quality of services to mobile subscribers, beside reducing call drops. BSNL expects to earn ₹300-400 crore a year through ICR arrangements starting this financial year.
